Amna Al Qubaisi made her Formula 4 debut when Round 1 of the Italian championship kicks off in Adria, Italy, on April 22, 2018, and became the first Arab woman to represent the region at this motorsport event. She holds the distinction of being the first Emirati woman to win the UAE's senior Rotax Max Challenge karting series in 2017.
